FFL DUES GRANT

The Friendship Force of Lincoln Qualifications, Criteria, and Application for a Dues Grant

Limitations:

- 1. A recipient is awarded the dues for Friendship Force Lincoln and Friendship Force International for a calendar year, January 1 through December 31.
- 2. A recipient may apply for a grant more than once but must complete an application each year.
- 3. A recipient agrees to complete the application and to follow through the way(s) they will volunteer their time and talents to offset the dues grant.

Qualification Criteria for a Diversity and Community Service Project Grant:

Applicants must:

- 1. Complete an application. See attached.
- 2. Support the goals and objectives of Friendship Force.
- 3. Be open to other cultures and people.
- 4. Be willing to volunteer their time and talents to Friendship Force.
- 5. Be 18 years of age.

Review Process for Dues Grants. The Scholarship Committee shall

- 1. Personally interview each applicant.
- 2. Evaluate the proposed volunteer activity(s).
- 3. Review all applications and make recommendations to the FFL Board of Directors for consideration for final approval.

Award Procedures:

- 1. The Scholarship Committee shall review applications and forward them to the Board of Directors for consideration for final approval.
- 2. Approval of grant awards shall require a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
- 3. The Board of Directors will decide within six weeks.
- 4. The Board will notify applicants in writing about the disposition of their application.
- 5. The number of grants awarded may vary from year to year. The Board reserves the right to refrain from granting an award in any given year.
